

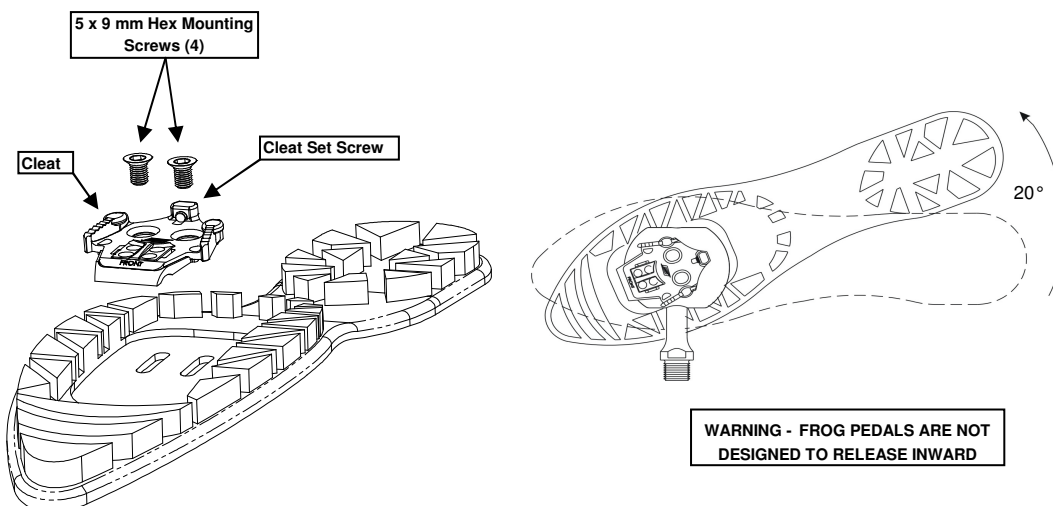

INCOMPATIBLE SHOES

Airwalk Sprocket and Urban	Current year & earlier	Larger sizes may have insufficient clearance with crank arm.
Alpinestars	1997 & earlier	Larger sizes may have insufficient clearance with crank arm.
Cannondale	Current year & earlier	Oversized toe box hits crank arm preventing release.
Nike Inyo & Amasa	Current year & earlier	Oversized toe box hits crank arm preventing release.
Scott 360, Magic & 4x4	2006 & earlier	Oversized toe box hits crank arm preventing release.
SPD-type sandals	Current year & earlier	Oversized toe box hits crank arm preventing release.
SPD-type boots	Current year & earlier	Oversized toe box hits crank arm preventing release.
SPD-type BMX / Freeride Flats	Current year & earlier	Larger sizes may have insufficient clearance with crank arm.

WARNING: You may experience interference with the crankarm during release on shoes with a large toe-box area, wide sole, or extra large shoes (size 14 and up), and therefore, these types of shoes may be INCOMPATIBLE or may require longer spindles to enable safe disengagement from the pedal. Replacement "Dog Bone" threaded inserts are available from Speedplay (Part #15005) for SPD shoes with factory inserts which have threaded portions that protrude beyond the surface of the sole.

CAUTION: Only Speedplay's 5x9mm hex mounting screws will fit FROG Series cleats. Consequently, all other screws are incompatible.
