

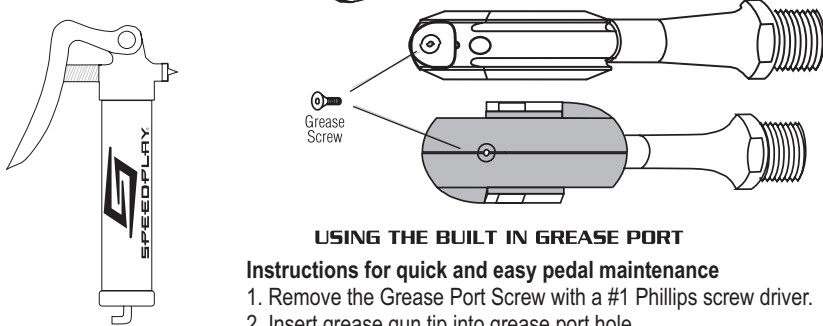
GREASING SPEEDPLAY PEDAL BEARINGS

IMMEDIATELY AFTER RIDING IN WET, RAINY OR UNUSUALLY DUSTY CONDITIONS.**

Warning: Use Waterproof Bearing Grease Only. Spray or liquid lubes such as oil, Tri-flow, WD-40 etc., may cause permanent damage. Parts damaged from lack of lubrication are not covered under Speedplay's warranty.

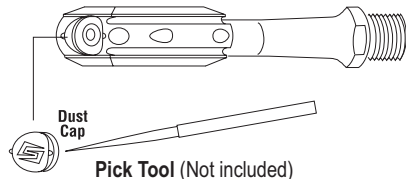
USING THE BUILT IN GREASE PORT

Instructions for quick and easy pedal maintenance

1. Remove the Grease Port Screw with a #1 Phillips screw driver.
2. Insert grease gun tip into grease port hole.
3. Pump gun slowly while turning pedal body slowly until clean grease is visible at spindle end of pedal body.
4. Wipe off excess grease and reinstall Grease Port Screw.

Note - Overtightening screw may strip the dust cap threads.

For Older Style X/1, X/2 Pedals



1. Remove old dust cap by prying under side tabs with sharp pick tool.
2. Install Speedplay's current X/1, X/2 Dust Caps into Pedal Body (Dust Caps available through your local Speedplay Dealer).
3. Follow Steps 1 - 4 above.

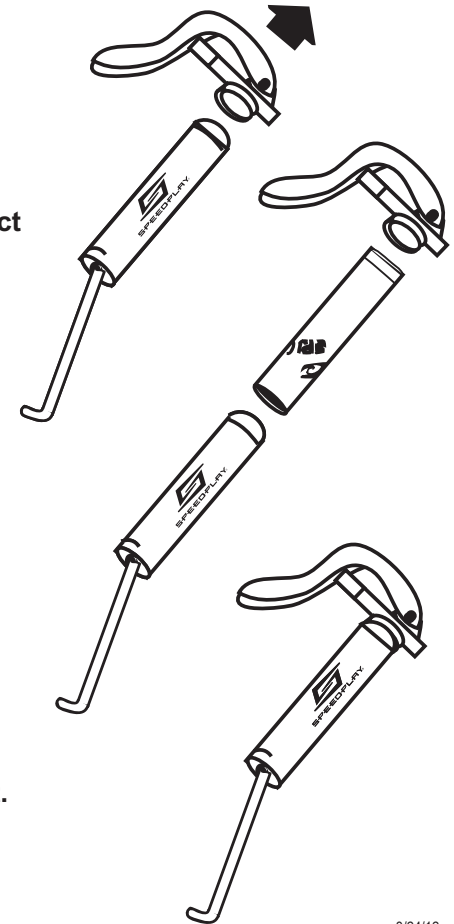
Grease Gun Loading Instructions

Features

All metal construction with
rugged painted finish.
Pistol grip for easy, one-hand
operation.
Uses standard 3 oz. grease
cartridge.
Compact "tool box" size - perfect
for hard to reach jobs.

Easy loading

1. Remove head cap.
2. Pull plunger rod and lock.
3. Remove cap from end of cartridge and insert in barrel (foil end of grease tube at top).
4. Pierce and remove center foil with sharp object.
5. Replace head securely. Do not over tighten.
6. Unlock plunger and slowly push into barrel.
7. Unscrew head cap about one turn to release air pocket.
8. Retighten head securely. Do not over tighten.
